**Gold Canyon Resources Inc. (GCU: TSX-V)** (“Gold Canyon” or “the Company”) is pleased to announce subject to regulatory approval, it has retained the services of Mr. Vic Weckerle of Vancouver, British Columbia to provide investor relations and administrative services to the Company.
